COLLINS TO JOYCE

Ryan Gatenby

Born/raised: I was born in Aurora, Illinois and raised in Oswego, Illinois, which at the time had a population of around 3,000 so our favorite activities included being really bored, having nothing to do, and complaining about it.



Education: I went to Oswego High School and then North Central College in Naperville to study communications and theater. Theater went out the window pretty fast when I realized how political and inside it could be so I focused on competitive speech (where I won over 50 awards) and the college radio station, WONC-FM, where I eventually became music director and started a new overnight show that was far more hip, happening, and now than the rest of their broadcast day. I received some scorn and derision from those who were resisting the growing alt-rock movement and took it very personally that I took away Billy Joel and Huey Lewis to add Nirvana and Pearl Jam.

Position: My current position is Program Director and Morning Host for WBIG-AM. I host "The Big Wakeup Call," the show where I talk to interesting people: athletes, actors, authors, musicians, and experts in their field. We've done about 2500 shows and I've conducted around 5000 interviews, including some of my rock and roll heroes like Elvis Costello, Mike Nesmith, and Johnny Rotten.

First job: My first actual job was working in the circulation department of the Aurora Beacon News. It was basically fielding calls from angry customers who didn't get their paper that day. On weekends I had to listen to the voicemail and write down all of the angry calls that came in when all 5 lines were busy with existing complainers.

Getting started in broadcasting: After college I did weekend overnights (Midnight to 8am) at WIIZ (The Wizard) in Lafayette, Indiana. Working as an alt-rock jock in the mid 90s (93-95) was an amazing experi-

ence, I got to hang out with all of the musicians traveling through town like Matthew Sweet, Material Issue, Elvis Costello, the Smithereens, Pearl Jam - so much fun and the station sadly went under because it was too hard of a sell in a town like Lafayette where the country station had about a 30 share and Alan Jackson sold out an arena in 11 minutes whereas Pearl Jam had tickets available the night of the show - and the show was delayed due to a bomb threat. Some local yokel probably afraid of those scary grunge rockers and their hippie friends.

Favorite music: I'm a big fan of 60s British Invasion (especially the Beatles - I must own over 100 books about them), 70s Power Pop and 90s alt-rock I play in a local band called The Unswept and we're a combination of Mersey Beat, 90s alt-rock, and the Traveling Wilburys.

Favorite Actor/actress: I don't really watch a ton of movies but I've always liked Will Ferrell, Paul Rudd & Steve Carrell. Kristen Wiig, Claire Foy and Olivia Colman are pretty great.

Favorite food: Burgers. Medium-well. Plain, no cheese, no toppings. Sauce on the side. I want to taste the meat. Always looking for the perfect burger. Best I've had is Ted's Montana Grill.

Favorite Sports teams: Cubs, Bears, Bulls, Blackhawks - clearly I'm another meatball Chicago sports fan.

People who taught you the most: My parents.

One thing you can't stand: Radio hosts who say "Dub-ee-you" or "Dub-uh-ya" or "Dub-ya" instead of "Double-you." Elocution is important!

Toughest decision as program director: Having to let some part-time producers go because they were unreliable. I hate firing people and it hasn't happened much but it never feels good.

Three words that describe you best: Witty, Clever, Goofy

Best advice you've gotten: Be real, be genuine, and be honest on the air and your listeners will relate to you and stay with you.

One thing you are afraid of: Bears. It's been well established they are Godless killing machines.

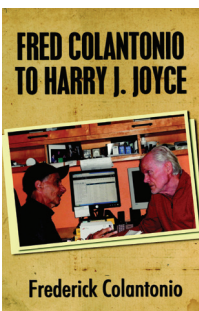
Hobbies: I like to write songs, play Wiffle Ball, and read biographies.

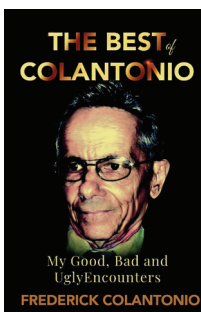

Fred Colantonio to Harry J. Joyce Colantonio has created a book composed of his interviews, impressions and recollections with professional ballplayers, managers, media people an author, business owners and regular folks. He found not everyone is willing to give even the slightest information about themselves for personal reasons and for reasons dictated by the management who employ them. With others he found them to be cooperative and warm.

The Best of Colantonio In his latest memoir, Colantonio is compelled to reveal facets of his life that have given him joy and caused him anguish. Discovering that bias, prejudice and intimidation continue into adulthood, he pours his heart and soul into his work. Undaunted by naysayers who have tried to impede his enthusiasm he proved them wrong by continuing to improve himself. Working full-time and going to college part-time he got his degree in Mass Communications from Columbia College of Chicago.

His radio career began in 1970 and lasted 37 years. His illustrious career in newspapers began with selling newspapers at his newsstand as a youngster. In 1960 he began reporting the news and it led him to become a newspaper sports journalist. As a journalist, he contributed articles to various newspapers in the Chicago area. He achieved his dreams by owning, publishing, editing and being the journalist of *The Chicago Sports Journal*.



Frederick A. Colantonio graduated from Columbia College of Chicago, with a B.A. Degree in Mass Communications (Radio). He has been a newspaper journalist since 1960 and a broadcast journalist since 1970 covering a variety of sports focusing on baseball and hockey. He has provided up-to-the-minute traffic reports for Chicago radio and his feature stories have been published in Chicago community newspapers. He is the publisher and journalist of *The Chicago Sports Journal*, covering stories from baseball, hockey and other sectors of sports and compiles in-depth interviews with owners, general managers, athletes and media directors.

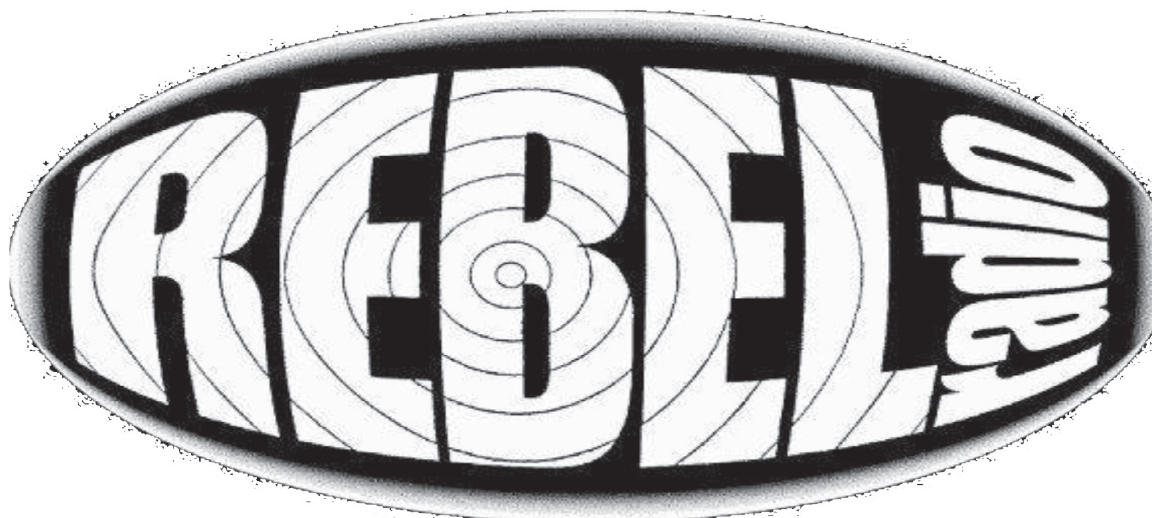
